

JOKER'S WILD

Description/Skill Cues

- This activity can be used a novel way to do a subject review and to incorporate some fun and activity at the same time. In advance, have some review questions (or math word problems) done up for a specific subject area. (Students could likely design some of these questions.) Spread out the set of Joker's Wild Cards on the floor. Teacher asks one of the review questions and chooses a student to give the answer. If the answer is correct, that student then can toss the rubber chicken amongst the wild cards stating "Ya Ba Da Ba Do" while doing the toss. Whichever card is closest to the beak of the chicken indicates what activity must be done by the class. Another question is then asked and another activity chosen by the toss of the rubber chicken and so on.
