

# VOCABULARY UNCERTAINTY

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GRADES: 4-6

FORMATION: Standing in their own personal space

EQUIPMENT: Vocabulary words, 4 Boxes

LEARNING OUTCOMES: LANGUAGE ARTS: Students will be able to identify key parts of speech and create sentences.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS: Remind participants to be cautious when moving and to be aware of the personal space of others. Check that the participants have enough space to perform the activities safely.

RULES/DIRECTIONS:

Vocabulary words are placed in boxes throughout the classroom. Boxes would contain Nouns, Verbs, Adjectives, and Adverbs. Each box has a labeled number. Students are divided into groups of four. When the teacher says “Go”, each of the students goes to a designated box, chooses one word and then the group tries to create a sentence whereby the words are used in the proper context. *I.e. Students must be able to place the nouns, verbs, adverbs and adjectives properly in the sentence.* Upon completion, the students must bring the completed sentence to the teacher who will confirm if it is correct. Students complete a designated exercise when complete!
