

WORD CIRCUIT

GRADES: 4-6

FORMATION: Standing in groups at designated stations

EQUIPMENT: Word cards related to Halloween (or any other theme)

LEARNING OUTCOMES: LANGUAGE ARTS: vocabulary and sentence construction

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS: Remind participants to be cautious when moving and to be aware of the personal space of others. Check that the participants have enough space to perform the activities safely.

RULES/DIRECTIONS:

The teacher creates four circuits in the classroom and divides the students into small groups of 4-6 depending on the class size. Students will begin at a designated station. Each station will contain 6 word cards related to Halloween (or any other theme). When the teacher says “Go”, students are required to create as many sentences as possible in one minute with the six word cards. At the end of 1 minute, the students must say their sentences out loud. The group who created the most sentences will determine a 2 minute physical activity. Students will rotate clockwise after each station is complete.
