

MOVE CUBES AND DICE

Description/Skill Cues

- The idea is to demonstrate how the Move Cubes and Dice could be used in the classroom setting.
- The Dice (or the Move Cubes with numbers inserted) can be rolled two at a time to teach time tables. After a student gives a correct answer, students will do that many reps of a certain physical activity. That student can then roll the dice (or move cube) for the next question. (As a challenge, students can roll the two cubes and the two dice and ask them to add or multiply all four to get the answer.)
- The Move Cubes can also be used for the selection of questions for any subject area. For example, if a class is studying Provinces of Canada, each side of the cube could be labeled with the name of one particular province. The Cube is rolled, and if Alberta comes up, then students are asked a question for review on Alberta. The student who gets the correct answer rolls the move cube and dice to see how many of any activity is done before the next question.

Suggestions

- Have groups of students to make up their own review questions for Endangered Species, Literary Terms, or Periodic Table of Elements.
