



Healthy Schools Grants Application Form

The Western Regional Wellness Coalition (WRWC) is dedicated to the promotion of healthy living and wellness to all people in the western region through a variety of organizational and community activities, events, and projects. A number of wellness priorities have been identified, which include: Healthy Eating, Physical Activity, Tobacco Control, Injury Prevention, Mental Health Promotion, Environmental Health, Child and Youth Development and Health Protection.

Schools in the western region of Newfoundland and Labrador, who are interested in promoting healthy living and wellness throughout their school community are eligible to apply for project funding through the WRWC. The maximum amount of funding that may be requested is \$500.00. To receive funding, the project must be consistent with the objectives of the WRWC in promoting wellness and focusing on the wellness priorities identified in the previous paragraph.

All successful grant recipients are required to return a completed activity tracking form (provided by the WRWC) after the event is completed. We ask that you display the WRWC logo during the event. If promotional items are required please indicate on the application.

Schools are eligible for one grant per school year. **Deadlines for grant applications are November 15th and February 15th.** Please allow for a 4-week turnaround after the deadline when submitting your application. Activities that have already begun prior to review date will not be funded.
